

## Dressing and Bandaging Wounds

### IMPALED OBJECT IN EYE

	Points Possible	Points Awarded
Takes or verbalizes BSI precautions	1	
Object manually stabilized in place	1	
Injured eye dressed; cup or roller gauze applied over/around to stabilize object	1	
Opposite eye closed and dressed	1	
Both eyes effectively bandaged	1	
Contact physically maintained with patient throughout	1	

### SUCKING CHEST WOUND

Takes or verbalizes BSI precautions	1	
Gloved hand used to prevent further outside air into chest cavity	1	
Occlusive dressing applied to open wound	1	
Occlusive dressing held in place by tape or bandages	1	
Patient positioned to maintain airway and breathing	1	
Describes signs of tension pneumothorax observed for	1	
Appropriate oxygen applied to assist breathing	1	

### LACERATED SCALP

Takes or verbalizes BSI precautions	1	
Indirect pressure is applied to wound	1	
Scalp laceration dressed with bulky material	1	
Dressing handled to maintain sterility	1	
Bandage checked for bleed-throughs	1	
Bandage able to stay in place and hold pressure, but still allow circulation	1	

### LACERATED KNEE

Takes or verbalizes BSI precautions	1	
Laceration dressed with bulky dressing- <b>w/o pressure to popliteal</b>	1	
Sensory, motor function, and distal circulation checked before bandaging	1	
Dressing handled to maintain sterility	1	
Bandage tight enough	1	
Bandage checked for bleed-throughs	1	
Sensory, motor function, and distal circulation checked after bandaging.	1
