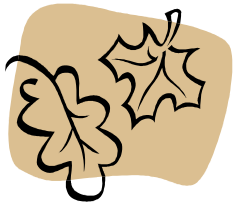

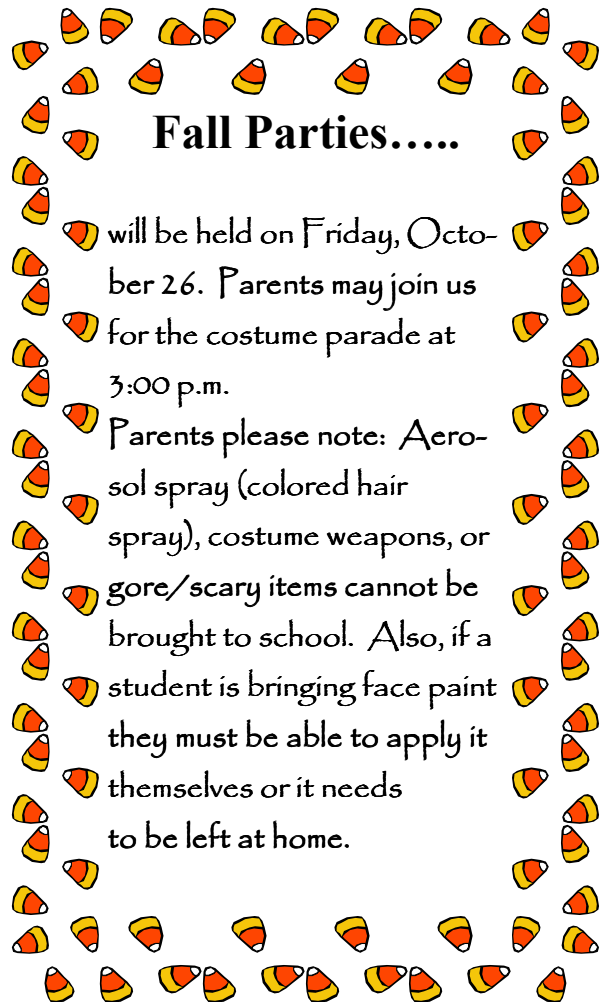
From the Media Center
