## Learning Modes and Teams

New this year, freshman/sophomore students will first choose their preferred mode of learning, or how they want to learn. There are three choices - school-based, flex (hybrid) or online. For students who choose school-based, they can select a traditional day with six periods or a flexible day. From here, 10th graders are placed on teams for their four core courses to foster strong relationships among students and teachers and support high school success.

School-Based with
five days per week at school.

Flex (Hybrid) with 2-3 days per week at school (Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays) and other days from anywhere.

Online full-time with primarily asynchronous (on-demand) learning experiences.

Co-Created Learning Experiences are project-based courses students co-create with a teacher to achieve identified academic and life competencies. Learning happens in a variety of places and ways.
