

Health and **Safety** Measures Overview

We will follow guidance from the Minnesota Department of Health and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. This is an overview of the measures we will take when we are in open campus and modified campus schedules learning models.

OPEN CAMPUS AND **MODIFIED CAMPUS SCHEDULES**



FACE COVERINGS for students and staff while indoors. The district will provide masks to all students and staff, and all are able to wear their own mask if preferred.



HAND HYGIENE practices and education

- Hand Sanitizer available throughout the building
- Hand Washing and sanitizing upon arrival at school, before and after meals, before and after recess and throughout the day



PHYSICAL DISTANCING

• No large group gatherings or events



CLEANING AND DISINFECTING of frequently used surfaces to happen throughout the day



NO VISITORS unless pre-approved through building principal



SCREENING AND RESPONDING TO ILLNESS

- Students/Families and staff to self-screen for COVID-19 symptoms before coming to school. If COVID-19 symptoms are present, they will not come to school and will inform the school.
- Protocols for illness and exposure, including isolation at school if needed

ADDITIONAL MEASURES FOR **MODIFIED CAMPUS SCHEDULES**



PHYSICAL SPACES will be maintained at physical distancing of at least 3 feet

- Hallways will be divided in half, and marked similar to a roadway, to create traffic flow patterns that maximize physical distancing
- Classroom and school schedules to limit physical interactions beyond a student's classroom and team
- Floor markings to ensure physical distancing in waiting areas
- Student seating arrangements where students are at least 3 feet apart



MEAL SERVICES

- · Meals to be eaten in classrooms or cafeteria with cohort, maximizing social distancing and with precautions for allergies
- *Meal purchases* will be made using a touch-free system
- · Meals will be individually plated/packaged; No self-serve food stations



TRANSPORTATION

- Buses will transport students of families that choose to utilize transportation services
- All riders maintaining 6 feet of distance from the bus driver
- Seating charts will be used; Siblings can sit together
- Loading and unloading procedures will maximize physical distancing to the greatest extent possible
- Buses cleaned and disinfected by the driver between routes
- · Students and driver to wear face coverings on the ride
- · Windows to be open, as weather permits, and ventilation systems maximized to promote air flow throughout the bus
