	10200	Band 6 6 th Grade Band is a continuation of a beginning band experience. Students who have not been given the opportunity to play an instrument may still enroll. Band is a yearlong course and performs twice per year. Students receive individual/small group lessons throughout the school year. Rhythmic skills include rhythms up to paired eighth notes and includes playing in keys of Bb and Eb concert.	3
	10300	Choir 6 This course provides opportunities in creating, listening to, performing and responding to music. Through the study of vocal music students will learn about the elements of melody, rhythm, form, texture, harmony, timbre, and expression in music. Basic musical skills and vocal tone will be emphasized. An introduction to choral singing will be a major theme. A variety of choral music representing many styles and cultures will be used throughout the year. Students will demonstrate their learning both in class and during public performances in the evening. Concerts take place approximately twice per school year.	3
	10400	Music 6 This course provides many opportunities in creating, listening to, performing and responding to music. Multiple instruments including percussion, tone bells, keyboards, and the voice will be used to learn about the elements of melody, rhythm, form, texture, harmony, timbre and expression in music. A major theme will be development of popular music in the United States. A variety of classroom performances and activities will take place.	3
	10301	Choir 6 (zero hour – 7:30-8:20 a.m.) *If you are in Band and would be interested in choir experience as well. Parents will be notified if and when this starts.
